



## **BERRIES YAK MINK COLLAR**

#### **MATERIAL**

Yarn: Merino Yak Laines du Nord yarn gr. 50 for the following colors 14-15-5 - Or Optional Yarn: Gr 50 cc Yarn Laines du Nord Mink color 9. Circular needles: nr 5 - 80 cm cable, 1 stitch marker (MP).

#### **POINTS USED**

Stockinette stitch, moss stitch, simple large holes (work distributed over a multiple of 8 stitches)

#### **SAMPLE**

CM 5 X5 = 9 stitches 13 rows.



#### **NOTES**

This neck is worked in the round with circular needle. The model does not have particular difficulties in making it, it is in fact a somewhat large tube, it only requires a little attention in the processing of the stitch with the double cast, in which multiples must be respected to return the staggered processing of the perforations.

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

### INSTRUCTIONS

**START** 

184 stitches 1 (used for closing in the round) CLOSE IN THE ROUND, put on stitch markers

With plum and work in stockinette stitch 6 rounds.

Now repeat from \* to \* throughout the 1st round: \* knit 2 together, 1 get \*

Change color light purple 6 rounds of moss stitch, now all in stockinette stitch until you have used up 1 ball of yarn.

Change color dark purple worked from MP  $^*$  1 stitch overlapped 2 times, knit 2 together 2 times, a double yarn over  $^*$ , until the end of the round always repeat from  $^*$  to  $^*$ 

Now work from Mp: \* 4 straight, in the double yarn over make 4 straight \*, Repeat from \* to \* for the entire round.

Work in stockinette stitch until the ball has run out.

Now work from MP  $^*$  1 stitch crossed 2 times, knit 2 together 2 times, a double yarn over  $^*$ , until the end of the round always repeat from  $^*$  to  $^*$ 

Now work from Mp: \* 4 straight, in the double yarn over make 4 straight \*, Repeat from \* to \* for the entire round.

5 rounds of stockinette stitch.

Starting from MP: 2 stitches knit together 2 times, \* a double yarn over, 1 crossed stitch 2 times, 2 stitches knit together 2 times \*, repeat from \* to \* end the round with 1 crossed stitch for 2 times





Now work from Mp: 2 straight, \* in the double throw make 4 straight, 4 straight \*. Repeat from \* to \* ending with 2 straight

5 rounds of stockinette stitch.

From MP  $^*$  1 stitch crossed 2 times, knit 2 together 2 times, a double yarn over  $^*$ , until the end of the round always repeat from  $^*$  to  $^*$ 

Now work from Mp: \* 4 straight, in the double yarn over make 4 straight \*, Repeat from \* to \* for the entire round.

5 rounds of stockinette stitch, 4 rounds of moss stitch

Optional change with Mink yarn or with another Merino Yak color,

1 round of reverse stitch

Now work in stockinette stitch until the ball has been used up.

Plum color change, 4 rounds of stockinette stitch.

Close very softly, sew the initial part on the wrong side and the final part on the lace work well, hide the pigtails.
