



### **ECO CROCHET FISHING HAT**

#### **MATERIAL**

YARN = ECO CROCHET by LAINES DU NORD, 1 ball each color: cream, orange.
CROCHET-HOOK = size 3.5 mm and 4 mm
OTHERS = darning needle, scissors, tape measure.

#### **POINTS USED**

Chain stitch, slip stitch, single crochet.

**Increase:** 2 sc into the same base stitch.

#### **MEASURES**

Single size

#### **MEASURES**

Height 19 cm Crown circumference 60 cm



#### **NOTES**

#### **SKILL LEVEL:** Easy

Work the hat top-down.

Everyone has their own way of working, so we recommend you make first 5 or 6 rounds to determine the right measures of the hat. If necessary, add or remove some stitches or rounds to fit your head circumference.

**Color change:** change the color at yarn over of sl st that close the round. For example, if you are working the closing sl st with orange yarn, insert the crochet-hook into 1st sc, cream yarn over the hook and pull it through orange loop, closing the sl st and shaping the cream loop to start new round.

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

RS = right side of work
WS = wrong side of work
st. / es = stitch / es
incr. = increase / ing
ch = chain stitch
col. = color
sl st = slip stitch
sc = single crochet
rep. = repeat / ing
foll. = follow / ing

#### INSTRUCTIONS

**1st round (RS):** using size 4 mm crochet-hook and cream col. yarn, work 1 ch (never consider it 1st sc), 8 sc inside the ring, pull the end to tighten the ring; close the round with 1 sl st in beg. sc.

**2nd round (RS):** 1 ch and 1 sc in 1st sc, 2 sc in each st. of the round, change with orange col. and cut the cream yarn (every time you change the color, cut the unused yarn). [8 incr. = 16 sts.]

**NB:** every time you change the color, move the cast-on tail of new color and closing tail of old color on WS, then work new sc (4 or 5 sts.) wrapping the tails, at last cut both tails.

**3rd round:** 1 ch and 1 sc in 1st sc, 1 incr., (1 sc in next st., 1 incr.) 7 times; close with 1 sl st in 1st sc of the round, changing with cream col. [24 sts.]

4th round: 1 ch and 1 sc in 1st sc, 1 sc in next st., 1 incr., (1 sc in next 2 sts., 1 incr.) 7 times; close with 1 sl st in 1st sc of the round, changing with orange col. [32 sts.]

5th round: 1 ch and 1 sc in 1st sc, 1 sc in next 2 sts., 1 incr., (1 sc in next 3 sts., 1 incr.) 7 times; close with 1 sl st in 1st sc of the round. [40 sts.]

6th round: 1 ch and 1 st. in 1st sc, 1 sc in next 3 sts., 1 incr., (1 sc in next 4 sts., 1 incr.) 7 times; close with 1 sl st in 1st sc of the round, changing with cream col. [48 sts.]

7th round: 1 ch and 1 sc in 1st sc, 1 sc in next 4 sts., 1 incr., (1 sc in next 5 sts., 1 incr.) 7 times; close with 1 sl st in 1st sc of the round, changing with il orange col. [56 sts.]





8th round: 1 ch and 1 sc in 1st sc, 1 sc in next 5 sts., 1 incr., (1 sc in next 6 sts., 1 incr.) 7 times; close with 1 sl st in 1st sc of the round. [64 sts.]

9th round: 1 ch and 1 sc in 1st sc, 1 sc in next 6 sts., 1 incr., (1 sc in next 7 sts., 1 incr.) 7 times; close with 1 sl st in 1st sc of the round. [72 sts.]

**10th round:** 1 ch and 1 sc in 1st sc, 1 sc in next 7 sts., 1 incr., (1 sc in next 8 sts., 1 incr.) 7 times; close with 1 sl st in 1st sc of the round, changing with cream col. [80 sts.]

**11th round:** 1 ch and 1 sc in 1st sc, 1 sc in next 8 sts., 1 incr., (1 sc in next 9 sts., 1 incr.) 7 times; close with 1 sl st in 1st sc of the round, changing with orange col. [90 sts.]

Cont. working same number of sts.

**From 12th to 25th round:** 1 ch and 1 sc in 1st sc, 1 sc in each next sc; 1 sl st in 1st sc of the round. Across these 24 rounds alternate the colors as foll.: 12th orange, 13rd-14th cream, 15th orange, 16th cream, 17th-18th orange, 19th-20th-21st cream, 22nd orange, 23rd cream, 24th orange, 25th cream.

The crown measures 17 cm in height approx., if necessary, add or remove some rounds.

#### **Brim**

Cont. using cream yarn and size 3.5 mm crochet-hook.

1st round: 1 ch and 1 sc in 1st st., 1 incr. in next st., (1 sc in next st., 1 incr. in next st.) 44 times; 1 sl st in beg. sc. [135 sts.]

From 2nd to 8th round: 1 ch and 1 sc into the same st., 1 sc in each next st.; 1 sl st in 1st sc of the round. Across these 7 rounds, alternate the colors as foll.: 2nd cream, 3rd-4th-5th orange, 6th-7th-8th cream.

9th round: with cream col. work 1 sl st in each st. of the round. Cut and tie off the yarn then, using the darning needle, hide the ends on WS.
